

Here's the pattern we used to make our faux facial hair. You'll need one-sixth of a yard of fake fur in a shade that closely matches your hair. Cut the above pattern out of paper, then trace it onto the wrong side of the fabric, making sure the nap of the fur runs from top to bottom (not bottom to top or side to side). For best results, slide your scissors in under the long hairy portion of the fur and cut only the fabric base. That makes for a more natural looking beard. Cut the mouth hole in the same way. Sew or hot glue an elastic loop at each side of the beard, attaching it to the dots on the back of the fur fabric. To wear, simply slip a loop behind each ear, part the mustache and comb the mustache toward the corners of your mouth, and—voilà!—Homemade Hipster!

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
