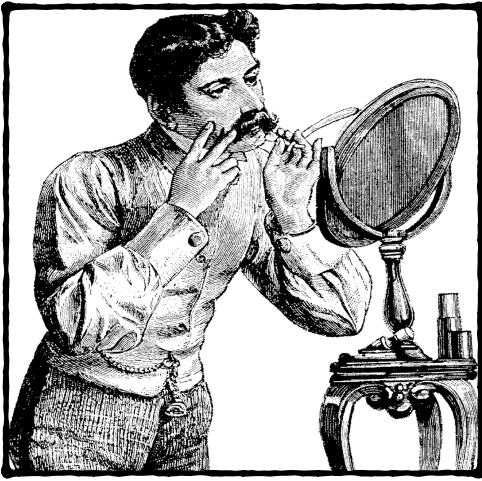

1. Which US President did NOT wear a mustache?
 - c. William McKinley: Our 25th president, McKinley was assassinated in September 1901, six months into his second term.
2. Why did Hitler choose the particular style mustache he wore?
 - d. It allowed his gas mask to fit more snugly: The large handlebar mustache he'd worn formerly allowed gas to seep in around the corners of his mask, so he started shaving the sides during WWI, as did many of his fellow German soldiers, for the same reason.
3. What style mustache was worn by the magician in the Christmas classic, *Frosty the Snowman*?
 - a. handlebar (like the one pictured in the graphic above)
4. The average man with a mo touches it how many times per day?
 - c. 760: That's about 31 times an hour or once every two minutes!
5. A mustache is capable of absorbing what percentage of its own weight in water?
 - b. 20%: It can hold 20% of its weight in buttermilk, as well—maybe even more.
